### Opening hours

- June – August: 10.00 – 17.00
- September – May: 11.00 – 17.00, Wednesdays 11.00 – 20.00

### Admission

- Admission fee: 180 SEK (also applies to seniors and students)
- Children and youth up to 19 years old: free admission
- Half price every day 16:00 – 17:00 (except Wednesdays): 90 SEK
- Half price on Wednesday evenings 17:00 – 20:00: 90 SEK
- Half price for students on Sundays: 90 SEK
- Companions have free entry
- Guides/tour leaders have free entry
- Admission to The Economy Museum located in the same building is included in the ticket.

- June – August: Daily tours of The Viking World in Swedish or English
- It is allowed to bring your own guide. Authorized guides enter for free.

- Weekends and Wednesdays: 17.00 – 20.00, 2400 SEK + 180 SEK per person
